Introduction	 Press Start/Stop button on touch screen Have customer grab the front handles and start moving the machine 	We're using Precision stitch regulation. The machine will respond to your movements. If you pause, it pauses. If you move the machine, it will stitch, giving you the consistent number of stitches per inch that we chose. Remember to press the Start/Stop button to stop stitching.	
Stitch Regulation and Icon-based Display	 Point out Precision setting on screen Explain using the touch screen or handlebar keys to navigate icon-based display Select Cruise Set Cruise speed to 700 spm Set 10 spi 	 Handi Quilter machines have two types of stitch regulation. We've been using Precision. Let's try Cruise. We use the handlebar keys or touch screen to navigate the easy-to-use icon-based display, making choices for our settings. This time, notice that when we press the Start/Stop button, the machine will immediately start stitching, and as you start moving the machine, it will adjust to the selected stitches per inch. Cruise mode is great for when you are doing a design with definite points, such as a star or zigzag. The machine will drop a stitch or two wherever you pause, resulting in a nice sharp point. It's a very smooth quilting experience. 	
Manual Speed Control	 Select Manual Set speed to 450spm Show how the "+" and "-" keys on the touch screen or handlebars to speed up and slow down the machine Set machine back to Precision 	Let's change to Manual Mode and give it a try. You are now in control of the stitch length, just as if you were quilting on your domestic sewing machine. You will notice that the machine sounds different and feels freer in manual versus either of the stitch- regulated modes. You can change the speed using the + or - keys on the touch screen or handlebars while stopped, or on the fly. The steady stitching pace in manual mode is great for micro-quilting and designs you are confident with, as well as overall edge-to-edge designs.

Threading and Adjustable	 Make sure machine is threaded properly If you have any tension problems while demoing, adjust as you go, explaining what you're doing 	The HQ Moxie XL is easy to thread. The thread path is very similar to your home sewing machine.	
		It has an M-class bobbin, the largest on the market. When using bobbin-weight thread, it holds almost twice as much as your domestic machine bobbin. Fewer bobbin changes!	
Tension		Tension is easy to adjust by turning the dial.	
		The beauty of these machines is that you can use any high-quality thread and simply make adjustments to the bobbin case and the top tension knob to accommodate.	
Lighting	Select LightsUse touch screen	The HQ Moxie XL has LED lighting that puts light right where you need it most. There may be situations when you want to dim or turn the lights off, such as when stitching on black fabric with black thread.	
Handi Feet Foot Mount	 Point out the Handi Feet Foot Mount Show various accessory feet with samples 	The machine comes with the Closed-toe Foot installed. This is the foot you will use for most free- motion quilting and ruler work. In the accessory pack you will find the Open-toe Foot, that allows you to more clearly see the needle and is usually used for micro-quilting. There are also many fun optional feet that you can add! These include the Glide Foot, the set of Echo Feet, and the set of Couching Feet, as well as the Sure Foot – an extra deep foot used for ruler work with thicker batting – and the Micro Foot, which gives the perfect view for detailed quilting.	
Over-speed Alarm	Select AlarmReturn to Menu	The machine has a built-in alarm that will sound when you out-stitch the stitch regulator. You may choose to have the sound turned on or off. Think of it as training to accomplish smooth and regular stitching.	
Ruler Base	 Show a Ruler Base and demonstrate how it is attached Show a selection of rulers 	The optional HQ Steady-Fit Ruler Base is a must for using longarm rulers or templates. It gives a secure steady place to balance and control the templates as you are stitching. Rulers or templates allow us to stitch perfect straight lines, perfect curves, circles or waves. It's very similar to using a ruler to draw a line on paper. There are many shapes and sizes from which you can choose.

Needle-stop Position	Select Needle StopReturn to Menu	Choose whether you want the needle to be up or down in the fabric when you press the Stop key. Most of the time you'll want it set for down so that you can continue quilting exactly where you left off.	
System	Select System InformationReturn to Menu	System Information is where you will find the hardware and software versions of your machine and display.	
Information and Updates	 Select Update Return to Menu Point out USB port on the left side of the nose of machine 	From time to time there may be updates that can be downloaded from the HQ website. Simply transfer with a USB stick using the port here. You can easily keep your Moxie XL up to date with any new features that become available. This port also supports USB-based accessories.	
Lifetime Stitch Count	Select Stitch CountReturn to Menu	You have a stitch counter on the HQ Moxie XL: the Lifetime count (like an odometer). This keeps track of every stitch made by your Moxie XL. You cannot reset it.	
Laser Light and Pantographs	 Have a simple pantograph laid out on the table at the back of the machine Note: Table top is an option to be added if pantograph capability is desired 	Back handlebars, a laser light, and table top are optional accessories available to add to your Moxie system. They will allow you to quilt using pantographs. This is a pantograph, a paper pattern that you can follow with the laser light and quilt the lovely design on your quilt.	
Cleaning and Maintenance	 Remove bobbin Show where the drop of oil goes on the rotary portion of the bobbin basket 	Handi Quilter longarms use the largest bobbin in the industry, the M-class. User maintenance is very simple. Just keep it clean by dusting out the bobbin area (canned air is approved for use with the Moxie XL, because there is a baffle behind the bobbin area that keeps lint from blowing into the machine). Put a drop of oil on the bobbin race with every bobbin change. We recommend bringing your machine in for lubrication and service every 1-2 years.

HQ Loft Frame	• Loaded with top, batting, and backing	The 8-foot HQ Loft Frame is based on a four-pole system, so you never have to adjust the sides up or down. You roll the quilt top and quilt back on the two front poles. The finished quilt is rolled up on the take-up pole on the back. The purpose of the idler pole, here at the back, is to keep the quilt sandwich level with the base of the machine. This ensures the best stitch. The four-pole system is superior to a three-pole system which requires constant adjustment to the poles. The height of the fame is adjustable to your comfortable quilting height. Optional rolling caster wheels are available if you think you'll need to move the machine around. Choose the loading method you prefer when you are setting up your frame: HIGH Position provides visual reminder of the actual quilting space and easy access to the bobbin area for oiling and bobbin changing. LOW Position is an option that allows for easy use of longer or larger rulers or templates. The Loft frame can be expanded with a 2-ft extension, available as an accessory.
